We are also taking additional measures to ensure the health and safety of our patients and staff:

We are providing multi-stage screening for all patients:

- Pre-appointment - We will call all of our patients two days prior to their scheduled appointments to determine if they are experiencing any symptoms.
- Appointment - We will be screening our patients upon entering our office on their current health condition.
- We have made hand sanitizer available upon entering, throughout your visit, and upon exiting our practice.
- We continue to sanitize all service rooms in our practice and highly trafficked areas multiple times a day.
- We are limiting physical contact outside of exam rooms.
- We are streamlining our appointments to avoid crowded waiting rooms.
- We have notified our staff to stay home if they feel any symptoms related to COVID-19, feel they may have been exposed to it, or have any other reason to do so.
- We encourage all of our patients to inform us if they are experiencing any symptoms of cold or flu and will gladly work with you to reschedule an appointment
